

Wedding Locations in Yosemite National Park  
Park Permit required - \$150.00 (non-refundable)

Yosemite Valley

- Lower Yosemite Falls - Open all year - 50 people max
- Swinging Bridge Picnic Area – Open all year - 20 people max, on sand beaches north of bridge, restrooms
- Cathedral Beach Picnic Area – May – October - 50 people max, tables/chairs allowed only in picnic area, restrooms
- Sentinel Bridge Picnic Area – Limited availability May – October – 100 people max, tables/chairs allowed only in picnic area
- Bridalveil Fall – Year round - 50 people max, and old roadbed beneath falls, restrooms

Wawona

- Wawona Point – June – October – 50 people max (call 209-372-1000)
- Upper Mariposa Grove – June – October – 50 people max
- Glacier Point – after Memorial Day – October – 50 people max
- Glacier Point Hut – November – May (X-C ski 10 mi to hut – call 209-372-1000) 50 people max, restrooms
- Chilnualna Falls Trailhead Parking Lot – Year round - 15 people max, restrooms at trailhead
- Sentinel Dome – June – October – 15 people max, walk-in ¼ mile
- Wawona Community Center – Year round – 100+ max, can accommodate over 100 people if using inside/outside. No more than 100 for inside use only
- The Lawn at the Wawona Hotel - \$100.00 for 45 minutes, chair set-up fee \$2.00/person

Tuolumne Meadows – After Memorial Day weekend through late October (weather permitting)

- Soda Springs – 50 people max
- Tenaya Lake Beach – 50 people max
- Tuolumne Meadows Lodge Area – 25 people max

Big Oak Flat - After Memorial Day weekend through late October (weather permitting)

- Tuolumne Grove – 30 people max
- Merced Grove – 30 people max

**Receptions in Wawona**

- The Sunroom at the Wawona Hotel - \$400.00/3 hours, \$600.00/4 hours
- The Lawn at the Wawona Hotel - \$400.00/3 hours, \$600.00/4 hours
- The Wawona Community Center - \$175.00 all day, with kitchen use \$225.00 all day

### **Important notes:**

- Site use is on a first-come basis, and is limited to two hours at all locations.
- Park visitors are not restricted from sites.
- If your wedding party is fewer than 10, you are not limited to these locations, exception for open meadows and riparian environs.
- Pets are not allowed at sites.
- No wedding sites are available on major holidays.
- Please respect park resources and tread lightly.
- For current road conditions: 209-372-0200 (Press 1)

The park entrance fee applies to all visitors. If you arrive in your private car, **the entrance fee is \$20 per car**. This is valid for unlimited entries to Yosemite for seven days, and includes all occupants of the car.

Otherwise, entrance fees are as follows:

\$10 per person if arriving on foot, horseback, bicycle, motorcycle, or on a non-commercial bus (free for those 15 years old and younger).

Commercial tours pay the following rates (a [special permit](#) is required):

- Commercial sedan (up to six seats): \$25 (plus \$10 per person)
- Commercial van (7-15 seats): \$125
- Commercial mini bus (16-25 seats): \$200
- Commercial motor coach (more than 26 seats): \$300

(Note that fees are based on capacity, not on occupancy.)
